PEWSEY TENNIS CLUB – ‘TENNIS FOR ALL’

MEMBERSHIP – CATEGORIES/ ELIGIBILITY/VOTING RIGHTS

The Club operates an Open Access policy at all times.

Persons of either sex are eligible for FULL MEMBERSHIP of the Club provided they are 18 years old. Persons below the age of 18 may be elected as Junior members without the right to hold office or vote at general meetings.

The following categories of membership are available:

FAMILY – up to two adults and children up to 18 years of age/unlimited access.

SENIOR - 21 years and over – unlimited access.

MID-WEEK – 21 years and over, access limited to weekdays between 9a.m.-6p.m.

INTERMEDIATES – over 18 years and under 21 years – unlimited access.

JUNIORS UNDER 10 – implied.

JUNIORS OVER 10 – implied, may attend Clubnight (Wednesdays) if playing in a senior team.

STUDENT - 18 years and over if in full-time education (college/university)

Ages above refer to the person's age on April 1st, or date of joining if this is later.

Only FULL MEMBERS (Senior, Intermediate & Family Seniors) may vote at general meetings. Membership commences on April 1st each year.

WIMBLEDON TICKET BALLOT – ELIGIBILITY/RULES:

The Club ballot is held according to the current guidelines issued by the LTA and may be subject to change in the future.

Only club members who are also members of British Tennis (to join call 0845 873 7202 or visit www.lta.org.uk/BritishTennisMembership) and over the age of 9 years are eligible.

(Juniors under 16 must have the permission of a parent or guardian to purchase tickets and must also be accompanied by an adult when they attend the Championship.)

British Tennis Membership is free until at least 2012, and it will be renewed each year automatically until then. Current indications are that it will remain free thereafter.

By joining BTM you help the Club ensure we have a good number of pairs of Wimbledon tickets for the annual Ballot.

The Club Ballot is held on the Opening day of the season (Sunday April 11th) at midday and all eligible members wishing to enter the draw must be present and have paid their 2010-11 subscription. If unable to attend for a valid reason, e.g. abroad, then a Proxy entry may be given to the Chairman in writing or by email to ColinGratton@talktalk.net at least 24 hours before the draw.

All Family Members over 9 years old are eligible for entry but ONLY ONE PAIR OF TICKETS can be won by any family membership.

Any member who is allocated Wimbledon tickets in the club ballot has to sign and return a copy of the club member ticket form to confirm that they will abide by the conditions of sale and distribution of tickets. This form is to be signed and returned before the tickets are issued.
